A. Gray Flagged Polypropylene Floor Brush

Fine sweep. Gray, polypropylene bristles are flagged for sweeping dust and fine particles on smooth surfaces. Trim 3".

B. Black Tampico Floor Brush

Fine/medium sweep. Tampico fibers resist heat and chemicals. Trim 2½".

C. Palmyra Fiber Floor Brush

Coarse/heavy sweep. Natural palmyra fibers for sweeping heavy debris. Trim 3½".

D. Stiff Polypropylene Floor Brush

Coarse/heavy sweep. Stiff maroon polypropylene bristles hold up on rough surfaces. Not affected by water or petroleum products. Trim 3¼".

E. Medium Black Polypropylene Floor Brush

Black synthetic polypropylene bristles for heavy- to medium-duty sweeping. Ideal for both rough and smooth surfaces. Water/chemical resistant for outdoor or indoor use. Trim 3".
